Applying for the Apprenticeship



Requirements

- ✓ Must be at least **18 years old** to join or be accepted into the program.
- ✓ Must have a high school diploma or GED.
- ✓ Must have two forms of legal identification; one with a picture.
- ✓ No experience required – in fact, even if you do have experience, we prefer that most people complete the entire apprenticeship program.

About the Program

Arizona Pipe Trades Apprenticeship is a five-year, state-registered, plumbing and pipefitting apprenticeship program.

The program is **earn-while-you-learn**. You'll be placed on a job, under supervision of a qualified journeyman, while taking trade-related classes at our training center.

We have great appreciation for **military veterans** and have preference programs in place for those that have served. Details will be shared during the application and interview process.

Getting Started

1 Join the waitlist to apply.
